NAVPHIBASELCREEK INSTRUCTION 11014.5F

Subj: LIABILITY FOR LITTERING ON BOARD NAVAL AMPHIBIOUS BASE
LITTLE CREEK

1. Purpose. To advise all Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek (NAVPHIBASE LCREEK) personnel of the policy regarding the disposition of litterers. Changes to this instruction constitute a major revision; therefore, additions, deletions, or changes are not individually marked.

2. Cancellation. NAVPHIBASELCREEKINST 11014.5E is hereby cancelled and superceded.

3. Background. The Commanding Officer has used various means, including the promulgation of reference (a), to publicize and stress the need for base cleanliness. General responsibilities have been established for NAVPHIBASE LCREEK department heads, Storefront Directors, resident activities, and other persons residing on, or utilizing the facilities of, this base to assist in these efforts. However, improperly discarded trash (which includes cigarette butts) by the thoughtless litterer continues to plague NAVPHIBASE LCREEK and necessitates needless loss of work-hours to correct a situation which should never have existed.

4. Information. Each individual using facilities onboard NAVPHIBASE LCREEK, whether that person is on active duty, retired, civilian employee, family member, or a visitor has a personal responsibility to dispose of trash in an acceptable manner. To do otherwise is an indication of poor personal habits and is a violation of the law. The key, therefore, to obtaining a clean base and eliminating litter is mutual cooperation, education, and when necessary, corrective law enforcement.

5. Policy. It is the policy of this command that existing laws concerning littering will be actively pursued and enforced

onboard NAVPHIBASE LCREEK. References (b) through (d), which are applicable to NAVPHIBASE LCREEK, provide for a maximum penalty of a \$2,500 fine, confinement in jail for twelve (12) months, or both, if convicted of littering. Per reference (e), anyone observed by NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Security personnel throwing litter (which includes cigarette butts) from a vehicle will be stopped and issued a base summons for littering. In addition, the base decal will be removed from the automobile and on base driving privileges will be suspended for 30 days. The military litterer is subject to the provisions of reference (f), and may be awarded punishment at Commanding Officer's Nonjudicial Punishment or convicted and sentenced at court-martial. Such action, however, should not be necessary with proper concern and individual cooperation.

6. Action. Addressees are requested to give the contents of this instruction wide dissemination to all military personnel, family members, and civilian employees residing on or utilizing the facilities of NAVPHIBASE Little Creek.
