1. Purpose. To promulgate the rules and regulations governing the use of Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek (NAVPHIBASE LCREEK) Patio Areas at the Bay (includes "D" Street Patio). Changes to this instruction constitute a major revision; therefore, additions, deletions, or changes are not individually marked.

2. Cancellation. NAVPHIBASELCREEKINST 11106.6D is hereby cancelled.

3. Background. The NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Storefront Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Director is responsible for the organization and operation of the subject patios and shall ensure that the rules and regulations set forth in enclosure (1) meet requirements promulgated by reference (a) and directives of higher authority.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF NAVPHIBASE LITTLE CREEK PATIO AREAS

1. Mission. The "D" Street and NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Patio Areas (includes "D" Street Patio) are operated for the purposes of providing leisure time activities which effectively contribute to the mental and physical well being of military personnel and their family members.
2. Location. The "D" Street Patio Area is located on the Chesapeake Bay beyond the Snug Harbor Club at the end of "D" Street. The other NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Patio Areas are located on the Chesapeake Bay (beyond the Eagle Haven Golf Course, at the end of Hewitt Drive).
3. Extension of Privileges. The following personnel are authorized to use NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Patio Areas:
 - a. Active duty, reservist, retired personnel, DOD/NAF civilians of NAVPHIBASE LCREEK, and their family members.
 - b. Guests of the above personnel on a space available basis.
4. Operating Season. The Patio Areas will operate on a seasonal basis during the months of May through September. Normally they will open on Memorial Day and close the day after Labor Day. Swimming is not authorized.
5. Service Charge. There is no fee to sit or lie in the sand outside of the Patio Areas. There are feels charged for private functions which require reservations for use of Patio Areas.
6. Responsibility. The Storefront MWR Director is responsible for the management of the Patio Areas. Included in this responsibility is the maintenance and cleanliness of the dressing rooms, party areas, parking lots, and Patio Areas.
7. Facilities. The Patio Areas include the following:
 - a. Separate dressing rooms for men and women.
 - b. Party area.
 - c. Outdoor grills.

- d. Parking area.
- e. Sheltered picnic areas.

8. Operating Regulations. The following regulations will be followed by all patrons of the Patio Areas:

a. Glass of any kind will not be permitted on the patio or in the sandy areas at any time.

b. Personnel will clear the patios at the end of the operating hours except those having permission from the Storefront MWR Department to remain later.

c. Fires will be set only in barbecue pits or portable grills.

d. Attendees will be allowed to play volleyball in assigned areas.

e. No pets will be allowed in the patio or adjacent areas

f. Appropriate casual or summer attire is required.

g. No crabbing or fishing is allowed.

h. Any unbecoming conduct is prohibited

i. Swimming is not authorized.

j. Children under age 10 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

k. No landing or powerboats, sailboats, wind surfers, jet skis, or surfboards allowed.

9. Safety and Inspection. The Storefront MWR Director is responsible for:

a. Enforcing the sanitary and safety regulations in the Patio Areas in accordance with paragraph 8 above.

b. Inspecting all facilities, including dressing rooms and parking lots, daily to insure their cleanliness prior to opening time and throughout the operating hours.

10. Emergency Procedures

a. In cases of emergencies such as stroke, heat exhaustion, and personal injury, notify below personnel as soon as possible:

- (1) Central Dispatcher 462-4444/5
- (2) NAVPHIBASE LCREEK QD 462-7385/6
- (3) MWR Director 462-7905

Ensure the name and duty station of military personnel or home address of family members or guests involved in emergency situations are obtained and forwarded to the Storefront MWR Director to provide timely notification to insurance carrier.

11. Parties

a. Food Service Catering. All food catering services on the Patio Areas will be done by MWR. Outside catering activities are not permitted to operate on NAVPHIBASE LCREEK.

b. Alcoholic Beverages. Beer from kegs served in plastic cups and canned beer is allowed in the Patio Areas with responsible adult supervision of the sponsor. No other Alcohol is permitted of any kind unless provided by an authorized MWR bar server.

c. Reservations for Parties

(1) Authorized patron desiring the use of Patio Areas for parties should contact the Storefront MWR Office for reservations and assistance. Contracts and payments must be received two weeks prior to the date of the function.

(2) The authorized patron or sponsor signing the contract will be responsible for ensuring compliance with all operating regulations.
