1. Purpose. To promulgate rules and regulations governing the operation and use of the Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek (NAVPHIBASE LCREEK) Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental. Changes to this instruction constitute a major revision; therefore, additions, deletions, or changes are not individually marked.

2. Background. The Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Department NAVPHIBASE LCREEK is responsible for the organization and operation of the Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental at Lake Bradford. The MWR Department shall ensure that the rules and regulations set forth in enclosure (1) meet requirements promulgated by references (a) and (b) and necessary safety procedures.

3. Cancellation. NAVPHIBASELCREEKINST 1710.19D is hereby cancelled.

4. Review Responsibility. The Director, MWR Department is responsible for the review and updating of this instruction.

LAKE BRADFORD PEDAL BOAT CANOE RENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Mission. The NAVPHIBASE LCREEK Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental is operated for the purpose of promoting leisure time activities, which will effectively contribute to the mental and physical well-being of naval personnel and their dependents.

2. Location. The Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental is located on the bank of Lake Bradford directly across the street from the Gator Pool on "D" Street.

3. Extension of Privileges. The following personnel are authorized to use the Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rentals:

a. Active duty, reservists and retired military personnel and their dependents. Further patronage as listed in reference (a) and (b).

b. Guests of the above personnel when accompanied by the sponsor.

4. Operating Season. The Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental will operate on a seasonal basis, from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend, Monday through Sunday from 1100-1830.

5. Fees and Charges. Rental fees and charges are promulgated periodically by the NAVPHIBASELCREEK Notice 1710.

6. Operating Regulations. The following regulations shall be posted at the facility and adhered to by all patrons:

a. Only authorized patrons, 14 years of age and over, who present a valid identification card may sign for and receive equipment. Passengers under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. An adult is defined as a person 18 years of age or older.

b. All boats and equipment shall be inspected upon return, and the patron shall be charged for damages and abuse considered beyond that which is normally anticipated and expected during routine usage.

c. All boats and equipment shall be operated in a reasonable and prudent manner and unbecoming or unsafe behavior is prohibited.

d. Authorized patrons desiring to fish in Lake Bradford shall be required to have a current and valid Virginia State Fishing license.

e. The equipment shall not be permitted to leave the boundaries of Lake Bradford.

f. Associated safety equipment and life saving devices shall not be removed from the boats and patrons are required to wear life jackets.

g. All equipment shall be returned prior to 1830. Violators of this rule shall pay an additional two hour penalty for the equipment checked out and, in extreme cases, shall be reported to the Commanding Officer for possible further action.

h. Patrons are responsible for all damages, injury, or loss of life relating to or resulting from the use of equipment.

i. All equipment shall be issued from and returned to the Gator Pool.

j. Lake Bradford Pedal Boat and Canoe Rental shall follow the Gator Pool for closing due to weather conditions.
