
Encl: (1) Urinalysis Policy Statement

1. Purpose. To establish command policy on urinalysis testing and to identify specific units subject to urinalysis inspection as authorized by references (a) and (b).
2. Discussion. This directive reaffirms the Commanding Officer/Program Manager's support of the Navy's "Zero Tolerance" policy regarding drug abuse.
3. Objective. To ensure the security, good order, and discipline for personnel assigned to Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek (NAVPHIBASE LCREEK) and Regional Public Safety (REGPUBSAFETY) and to provide a strong deterrent against drug abuse using a program of positive command education and urinalysis testing.
4. Scope. Applies to all Navy and Marine Corps personnel attached to NAVPHIBASE LCREEK/REGPUBSAFETY directorates throughout Navy Region, Mid Atlantic, including personnel assigned on Temporary Additional Duty.
5. Action. The Commanding Officer/Program Manager is responsible for the Urinalysis Program and will appoint a Urinalysis Coordinator. The Executive Officer will direct urinalysis testing and scheduling through the Urinalysis

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Coordinator. The entire NAVPHIBASE LCREEK/REGPUBSAFETY chain of command, along with all hands, are responsible for enforcing the Command's Urinalysis Policy.

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URINALYSIS POLICY STATEMENT

1. In addition to the Random Selection Urinalysis Program conducted in accordance with references (a) and (b), all personnel assigned to Naval Amphibious Base Little Creek/Regional Public Safety directorates throughout Navy Region, Mid Atlantic who: Are turned over to base police or to a command representative as a courtesy turnover; who surrender or are apprehended after an unauthorized absence of 24 hours or more; or who enter into a pretrial restriction or restriction status, shall submit to urinalysis inspection as follows:

a. The Urinalysis Coordinator will be recalled for urinalysis testing under this policy.

b. All personnel tested under this policy will be tested as a subgroup of the command unit on the basis of a random inspection examination.

2. Urine collections will be conducted by the Urinalysis Coordinator. All urine collections, handling, and shipment to the Naval Drug Screening Laboratory will be completed in accordance with references (a) and (b).
